The Ohio Choral Directors Association is pleased to announce the 16th annual Ohio Choral Director's Association Children's Honor Choir, to be held at Otterbein University during the OCDA Professional Conference, June 22-24, 2020. Music teachers and community children's chorus directors who are members of OCDA and/or OMEA are invited to recommend their best treble singers who have just completed grades 4-8.

This extraordinary choir will be comprised of 120 of YOUR most committed and advanced singers. The combination of these wonderful children and the excellent teaching of our guest conductor will create an experience your singers will remember for years to come.

Celebrated for her artistic vision and top-tier choirs, Jeanne Wohlgamuth is a champion of choral education. Since beginning her tenure as Columbus Children's Choir artistic director in the spring of 2011, Mrs. Wohlgamuth has paved the way for a new and exciting era of the organization. Under her direction the New World Singers received a special invitation to sing with the Vienna Boys Choir in a tour of Austria and Hungary in 2017. She has expanded community engagement efforts to make Columbus Children's Choir a point of pride for the city of Columbus.

Alongside her work with Columbus Children's Choir, Mrs. Wohlgamuth is the fine arts department chair and director of choirs at Dublin Jerome High School, the vocal affairs chair for the Ohio Music Education Association, and a recipient of countless awards including the Community Champion Award presented by the Dublin Chamber of Commerce.

Mrs. Wohlgamuth has served as an adjunct professor in the master's of music education program at the Kodály Institute at Capital University and taught undergraduate choral methods. She has presented workshops on developing sight-reading in the choral rehearsal, and middle school choral techniques and repertoire for the Midwest Kodály Music Educator's Conference, The Ohio State University, Capital University, Columbus City Schools, the Tri-City Kodály Music Educators, and the Ohio Music Educators Association state professional conference.

## **Nomination procedure**

Online nominations will be accepted until March 15, 2019. Please make sure you have a valid phone number and current parent email address for each singer you nominate. Please rank your singer in the order in which you want them to be considered. This will help us select the singers from each school that will be most ready for this intensive experience.

## **Deadlines**

Nominations will be accepted: February 15 – March 15, 2019. All singer registrations must be complete by April 15, 2019. Detailed information will be sent via email directly to parents and teachers after May 1, 2019.

Participating students will begin preparations for the choir in two **required** satellite rehearsals held around the state. Dates and locations of satellite rehearsals will be published on the OCDA website as soon as they are available.
