 - Amy Gelsone (Historian) has been in the process of scanning printed items
 - There is a big bin full of archives that gets passed around with Executive Board changes
 - OMEA has historical items in BGSU archival collections
 - We are looking at doing the same with OCDA. It would be a companion collection to OMEA.
 - Could be searched on an online database; all items become property of BGSU
 - We have scans of all past newsletters
 - They have ability of tagging hard copies
 - We would sign a contract handing the rights over to BGSU
 - Information becomes public domain
 - Table discussion for now; Executive Committee to look at for report at winter board meeting

 - OCDA holds/sponsors 3 reading sessions at OMEA PD Conference
 - In addition we can sponsor 4-6 interest sessions

 - Under current system, we don't have quality control
 - Our name is on it as a sponsor so we would like to have the control to approve these sessions
 - Currently there is no standard process
 - President Moss wants to put forth a process to get an approval for OCDA to sponsor an interest session
 - Whomever was the "Choral Chair for OMEA session selection committee" was usually an OCDA member; now it's done electronically and not ensured that this person in an OCDA member
